Spanish – Year 7

 Reading	<p>From the Library: A selection of comic books</p> <p>From the library: Magazines</p> <p>From the MFL faculty: Borrow a book or a movie from the MFL faculty box - speak to your MFL teacher</p>
 Research	<p>Find out about other Hispanic countries and make a short PP presentation on one for the class</p> <p>Research a town in Spain and make a PP presentation for the class</p> <p>Research a famous Spanish sports person/artist and make a PP presentation for the class</p>
 Watching	<p>Peppa Pig on youtube in Spanish</p> <p>Watch a Spanish film with English subtitles.</p> <p>Watch a Disney film you know in Spanish with subtitles in English</p>
 Student-led	<p>Put the settings on your phone into Spanish to practice useful language</p> <p>Put the settings into Spanish on your favourite computer game. On FIFA, for example, you can set the commentary into Spanish.</p>
 Listening	<p>Listen to the free access Podcasts at <i>Coffeebreak Spanish</i>: Coffeebreak</p> <p>Searchable MP3 clips by topic, level and language: Audio Lingua</p> <p>Site for song activities in many languages using the text: Lyrics Training</p>
 Creative	<p>Make a video to learn a grammar point that you have learnt in class.</p>
 Trip/Visit	<p>If you have visited Spain, complete a short project on the region you visited. If not investigate a region in Spain you would like to visit and produce a short project.</p> <p>Write a diary about a trip to Spain you have been on and include photos</p> <p>Prepare a vocab booklet for a trip to Spain with key vocab and phrases</p>

Spanish – Years 8 and 9

 Reading	<p>Put your phone settings into Spanish to learn some useful vocabulary</p> <p>News website: Rtves</p> <p>News website: Elmundo</p> <p>Online stories some with video as well: The Spanish Experiment</p>
 Research	<p>Research a famous Spanish sports person and make a PP presentation for the class</p> <p>Research Madrid or Barcelona and make a presentation so you could encourage other students to visit these cities.</p> <p>Research a Spanish speaking touristic area and prepare a presentation.</p>
 Watching	<p>Watch a Spanish film with English subtitles.</p> <p>Put your favourite box set into Spanish with subtitles in English</p>
 Listening	<p>Some Spanish stories, some with videos that you can listen to and or read. The Spanish Experiment</p> <p>Put your favourite computer game into Spanish. On FIFA, for example, you can put the commentary into Spanish.</p> <p>Listen to the Podcast - <i>Coffeebreak Spanish</i>: Coffeebreak</p> <p>Searchable MP3 clips by topic, level and language: Audio Lingua</p>
 Trip/Visit	<p>Prepare a vocab booklet for a trip to Spain with key vocab and phrases</p>

Spanish – Years 10 and 11

 Reading	<p>Classic stories you will recognise free online: Famous Spanish Stories</p> <p>Some more Spanish stories, some with videos that you can listen to and or read. The Spanish Experiment</p> <p>From the Library: Mary Glasgow magazines</p>
 Research	<p>Research how, when and why Spain became a republic</p> <p>Explore why Spain is the number one tourist destination in the world, with 126 million visitors annually</p> <p>Research the geography and the political makeup of Spain</p>
 Watching	<p>Watch an episode of Friends or another favourite box set in Spanish</p> <p>Film: <i>Zipi y Zape</i> – el club de la canica a film set in a boarding school (ask for the link as it is on a drive)</p> <p>Film: <i>Los Intocables</i> – an excellent comedy film about a disabled man and his carer (it is available on Youtube or Netflix or ask for a link to the drive)</p>
 Listening	<p>Listen to the free content Podcasts at <i>Coffeebreak Spanish</i>: Coffeebreak or The BBC's mi vida loca's podcasts: Mi Vida Loca</p> <p>Searchable MP3 clips by topic, level and language: Audio Lingua</p> <p>Go onto Medicina sin Fronteras' website and listen to the presentations about their work all round the world MSF</p>
 Creative	<p>Plan a long weekend in Barcelona or Madrid.. What would you visit? How would you look into and book accommodation?</p> <p>Plan a week's holiday in Spain and work out an itinerary.</p> <p>Plan a ski trip to the Spanish Pyrenees or Granada and cost the week (skiing, accommodation, food and travel)</p>

Spanish – Years 12 and 13

 Reading	<p>Read another book by the author of your set book and write a review</p> <p>Go online and read El País or El ABC, and note down 20 new items of vocab: El País ABC</p> <p>Read the magazines in the library</p> <p>Read reviews of the films you have seen in the TL</p>
 Research	<p>Find out about another Hispanic countries and make a short PP presentation on one for the class Research the background period that your book/film is set in</p> <p>Research the possibility of working in Spain: Workaway Working in Spain Gap Year</p>
 Watching	<p>Watch another film by the filmmaker you are studying and write a review. Watch first with English subtitles and then with Spanish</p> <p>Watch a Spanish TV series on Netflix</p> <p>Watch one (or more) of these films: <i>Ocho apellidos Vascos</i> <i>Secretos del Corazón</i> <i>Durante la tormenta</i> <i>El hombre de las mil caras</i> <i>El autor</i></p> <p>Watch the daily news online: RTVE</p> <p>A great resource for new daily content from El País for all who are learning Spanish: El País</p>
 Listening	<p>Searchable MP3 clips by topic, and level : Audio Lingua</p> <p>Site for song activities in many languages using the text. Make sure you find Spanish songs! Lyrics Training</p> <p>Listen to the free content Podcasts at <i>Coffeebreak Spanish</i>: Coffeebreak</p>
 Creative	<p>Plan for a trip to a new area of Spain. Where would you go? What would you visit? How would you begin to plan your visit?</p> <p>Plan a week's holiday in Spain and work out the budget for transport, accommodation, food and activities.</p>
