Science

- Most students study Combined Science (Trilogy) worth 2 GCSEs
- Triple Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics): set 1 scientists and many set 2 scientists
- This takes up one of the 4 options and so would replace the 4th choice subject
- At least two 6s in Combined or Triple Science enables studying A levels in Science and a degree in a Science discipline






