Upon arrival at their appointed time, students should go to the Chapel where they will be given information about the testing process and school protocols. They will then be escorted to the LRC to start the testing process. Once they have been tested, students will be taken to the Sports Hall where they will wait until their result is released.

It is important the students arrive at the staggered times provided so that the tests can take place in a controlled, socially distanced manner. Students will remain in school for the entire day, following their test, according to their normal lesson timetable.

During the phased return, all students should enter the school via the main front gate (these will be the only gates open between 8.45 and 3.20pm).

On the day of their test appointments, students should (where possible) bring a smartphone to school in order to register for the test. Students will be asked to register themselves as part of this process on the NHS website using this phone. If your child does not have a smartphone, our staff will register them using a school device. Please ensure students know their smartphone number, as well as their postcode. It may also be helpful to download a QR scanner on your child's phone (if their phone and camera facility do not already allow this function). Students will be guided through the registration process by our experienced staff.

Students should also ensure they bring a book (or independent study) to read, if required, before taking their test and whilst their results are processed, before returning to their lessons.
