We are writing to confirm the details for your child's return to school next week.

Please see the table below for information regarding the return date and time for children who will not take part in the lateral flow testing.

Phased return: first day in school for students who are not being tested

Monday 8 March	Year 11	Students should arrive in school for 10.30am and go to their Period 2 lesson.
	Year 12	Students should arrive in school for the start of Period 5 (2.15pm) and go straight to their lesson *
	Year 13	Students should arrive in school for the start of Period 4 (12.25pm) and go straight to their lesson *
Tuesday 9 March	Year 9 B1, C1, H1, R1	Students should arrive in school for 11.00am and go to Chapel. They will be collected by their teachers and escorted to lessons
	Year 9 B2, C2, H2, R2	Students should arrive in school for 12 noon and go to Chapel. They will be collected by their teachers and escorted to lessons.
	Year 10	Students should arrive in school as normal for registration at 8.35am

Wednesday 10 March	Year 7	Students should arrive in school as normal for registration at 8.35am
	Year 8 B1, C1, H1, R1	Students should arrive in school for 11.00am and go to their Period 3
	Year 8 B2, C2, H2, R2	Students should arrive in school for 12 noon and go to Chapel. They will be collected by their teachers and escorted to lessons

* If Year 12 and Year 13 students do not have lessons at these times, they should study at home on Monday 08 March and return to school according to their normal lesson timetable

During the phased return, all students should enter the school via the main front gate (these will be the only gates open between 8.45 and 3.20pm).
